On May 19, 2011, after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on a charge of violation of § 30-46(5) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Proper notice of the hearing was provided to the Respondent, however, the Respondent failed to appear at the hearing.

Based upon the testimony and documents submitted at the hearing, the department finds that as of March 31, 2011, the respondent lost the right to occupy the permit premises in violation of the charge alleged and **ORDERS** the package store liquor permit **revoked immediately** in accordance with § 30-6-A8(c) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
