On October 3, 2013, after due and proper notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on a question of Sec. 30-20(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, to determine whether the premises meets the definition of a "grocery store," Sec. 30-6-A1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies concerning an alleged failure to supply required documents, and Sec. 30-6-A2 concerning the eligibility of the applicant. At the conclusion of the hearing, the record was left open to allow the investigating agent to revisit the location and submit a supplemental report and obtain an additional breakdown of sales form.

Based upon the testimony and documents submitted at the hearing, and the additional documents submitted subsequent to the hearing, the Department of Consumer Protection **ORDERS** your application for a grocery store beer permit **GRANTED**, subject to the final requirement that a substitute permittee application be filed.
