MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted to approve minutes of the January 10, 2011 Elevator Installation, Repair and Maintenance Work Examining Board meeting with amendments to page-2 under “Minutes From Previous Meetings” paragraph-2, to reflect that the Board requested Mr. DeRosa meet with the CT Department of Public Safety to discuss elevator safety issues. Mr. O’Reilly abstained from voting on this matter due to his absence at the Board’s January 10, 2011 meeting.

APPLICATIONS

Sudo Custovic, Windsor, CT – (R-7) Limited Conveyor Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Custovic’s application due to lack of a required (R-8) Limited Conveyor Journeyman license for a minimum of two years.

Mark Menendez, Greenwich, CT – (R-2) Unlimited Journeyman – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Menendez’s application due to lack of a required “Apprenticeship Completion Certificate”.

Scott T. Sneyd, Taunton, MA – (R-7) Limited Conveyor Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Sneyd’s application due to lack of required notarized statement(s) from his employing (R-7) Limited Conveyor contractor license holder attesting to his dates and duties of employment as an (R-8) Limited Conveyor. The Board is also requesting for verification of credentials regarding his occupational related experience and school related instruction experience that qualified him for the (R-8) Limited Conveyor Journeyman exam.

CHAPTER 46 - STATE APPOINTIVE OFFICERS

Sec. 4-1a. Appointed officers, unspecified terms. Unless otherwise provided by law, any appointed official of the state, including any person appointed to a board, commission, council, authority, task force, committee or other body, shall serve at the pleasure of the person or body authorized to make the appointment but no longer than the term of office of such appointing authority or until such official's successor is appointed and qualified, whichever is longer.
