APPEARING FOR RECONSIDERATION:

Joseph Agostino, Portland, CT – (D-2) Limited Journeyman

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Agostino's (D-2) Limited Journeyman application due to lack of documentation for proof of apprenticeship completion on October 15, 2015, and requested that Mr. Agostino appear before the Board. Mr. Agostino will appear for reconsideration of his application.

Waleed Alrukaibawi, Ashford, CT – (S-2) Unlimited Journeyman

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Alrukaibawi's (S-2) Unlimited Journeyman application due to lack of apprenticeship completion and related instruction on February 26, 2015. Mr. Alrukaibawi, along with his employer, will appear for reconsideration of his application.
