Review and approve minutes of the May 21, 2015 Heating, Piping, Cooling and Sheet Metal Work Examining Board meeting.

APPEARING FOR GUIDANCE:

Ronald Rutkowski, Jr., Unionville, CT

Mr. Rutkowski holds a (P-1) license and will be appearing for guidance on the licensing requirements and application procedure for the (S-2) license.

APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW:

Anthony Felicello, East Haven, CT – (S-10) Limited Journeyman

Anthony Felicello appeared before the Board on 3/19/15 and the Board voted to conditionally approve Mr. Felicello for the (S-10) examination contingent upon submission of application acceptable to DCP standards. (There was no application on file with DCP at this time.)

Subsequently, Mr. Felicello submitted his application to PSI and it was received at DCP on 3/25/15. Upon review of the application package by the Department, it was determined it was not complete due to the fact that it did not include “notarized statements from occupational related employers as to dates and duties of employment,” as stated as a requirement on the application. A letter was sent to the applicant stating that this additional documentation is needed.

Mr. Felicello will appear at today’s meeting to discuss his application and qualifications with the Board.

Robert Tremblay, Milford, CT – (S-10) Limited Journeyman

Mr. Tremblay appeared before the Board on 3/19/15 and the Board provided guidance regarding how to apply for the (S-10) license. At the 4/16/15 meeting, the Board reviewed Mr. Tremblay’s application and related documentation and, after discussion, voted to conditionally approve Mr. Tremblay for the (S-10) application contingent upon the submission of application acceptable to DCP standards. (There was no application on file with DCP at this time.)

Subsequently, Mr. Tremblay submitted his application to PSI and it was received at DCP on 6/5/15. The application is to be reviewed at today’s meeting.

In addition, the Board is to discuss this matter regarding pre-approvals without applications submitted first, which is contrary to existing law.

Mr. Chrysler, Sr.'s (SM-1) application was denied by the Board on 4/16/15 due to lack of (SM-1) license for the required two-year period. Mr. Chrysler changed the category of license sought from (SM-1) to (SM-2) and has resubmitted the application for the Board's reconsideration.

Matthew Buckley, Newport, RI – (B-1) Limited Contractor

Mr. Buckley's (B-1) application was denied by the Board on 3/19/15 due to lack of a (B-2) license for the required two year period. Mr. Buckley changed the category of license sought from (B-1) to (B-2) and resubmitted the application for the Board's review at the 4/16/15 meeting. After discussion, the Board voted to deny Mr. Buckley's (B-2) application due to lack of proof of on the job training.

Mr. Buckley has resubmitted his application with a notarized letter from his employer for review and reconsideration at today's meeting.

Mr. Gamble's (S-2) application was denied by the Board on 1/15/15 due to lack of proof of on the job training. Mr. Gamble has resubmitted his application with an employer letter for review and reconsideration at today's meeting.
