1. 9:30 A.M. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN.

4. DCP TRADE PRACTICES DIVISION COMPLAINT STATUS REPORT; review of complaint report submitted by the DCP Trade Practices Division including open, closed, and dismissed cases for review by the Board.

1. Continuation of discussion concerning the Department of Labor's Glazier Apprenticeship Program; for discussion by the Board. Mr. Satchell from the Department of Labor presented the Board with the Department of Labor's current work schedule for the Ironworkers Apprenticeship program.

Ms. Vanasse noted that this Board' position is that the Ironworkers Apprentice Program Work Schedule is not equivalent to the Flat Glass Apprenticeship Program's Work Schedule. She asked Mr. Satchell why the Department of Labor is issuing gold seal

Apprenticeship Completion letters for the Ironworker's applications. Mr. Satchell did not have an answer other than a process is in place and until otherwise instructed, the process will continue.

The Board asked that Mr. Mark Stankiewicz, Program Manager, from the Department of Labor Apprenticeship Training Division be invited to attend their next meeting for a discussion on the Flat Glass and Ironworker Apprenticeship Programs.

2. Pending Regulation changes requested by the Board to DCP Legislative Program Manager. The Department's Legislative Liaison is retiring. When the Department hires a replacement, that person can be invited to a future meeting to address the Regulation changes.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Review of Applications:

1. Application of Mr. Kevin S. O'Neill for a Flat Glass Unlimited Contractor's license (FG-1); for review and discussion by the Board. The Board voted unanimously to approve the applicant for the Flat Glass Unlimited Contractor's Examination. (Von Dassel/Wisniewski)

2. Application of Mr. Ryan M. Rossi for a Flat Glass Unlimited Journeyman's license (FG-2); for review and discussion by the Board. The Board voted unanimously to deny the applicant for the Flat Glass Unlimited Journeyman's Examination based upon the lack of on-the-job training and related classroom instruction.
