1. Exemptions from Well Drilling regulations

Occupational and Professional Enforcement Unit has gathered facts regarding a well location at 1 Easy Street, Sterling, Ct.

The yield at such location is less than the required minimum yield.

Board to consider size of home to be served, number of bedrooms, and total count of plumbing fixtures, well location, depth, casing, static water level, yield, and amount of space available for potential storage capacity.

CHAPTER 482 WELL DRILLING

Sec. 25-133. Exemption. Where the board finds that compliance with all requirements of this chapter or regulations adopted pursuant thereto would result in undue hardship, an exemption from any one or more of such requirements may be granted by the board,

subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Consumer Protection, to the extent necessary to ameliorate such undue hardship and to the extent such exemption can be granted without impairing the intent and purpose of this chapter.
