The Inland Water Resources Division of the Department of Environmental Protection has reviewed the flood management certification prepared by J. Andrew Bevilacqua and signed by Al Richmond of the Connecticut Department of Education. The certification document dated September 21, 2010, submitted on September 29, 2010 with additional information submitted throughout October 27, 2011 states that the proposed activity has been designed in compliance with the requirements of Section 25-68d(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and Section 25-68h-1 through 25-68h-3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA).

The project consists of constructing a segmental block retaining wall to prevent Padanaram Brook bank erosion and potential driveway undermining adjacent to the Henry Abbott Technical High School in the Town of Danbury as shown on plans entitled "Henry Abbott Technical School Padanaram Bank Stabilization and Hayestown Avenue Crosswalk Design," dated January 29, 2010 and signed by J. Andrew Bevilacqua, P.E. The project is located within the 100-year floodplain associated with the Padanaram Brook.

The above referenced certification is hereby approved. No revisions or alterations to the approved plans are allowed without first obtaining written approval from this Division of such alterations.
