Re: Fall 2012 Fire Marshal/Inspector Module and Fire Investigator Module
Training Announcement

The Office of Education and Data Management, in cooperation with the Office of State Fire Marshal, will be conducting the Fire Inspector Pre-Certification Module and the Fire Investigator Module in the fall of 2012. **Applicants Must Choose Only One of the Two Modules.** The Fire Inspector Module and the Fire Investigator Module will both be offered in the spring of 2013 also.

Applicants must meet the following criteria *to be considered* for enrollment:

- 1) Candidate must be at least 18 years of age
- 2) Candidate must have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- 3) Appointing Authority must provide signed statement indicating that s/he will appoint applicant upon successful completion of program.

Applicants who meet the above criteria will be considered based on the need for certified fire officials in the community they are to serve. If submitting more than one applicant for a jurisdiction, selection will be based on the priority assigned to each applicant. (Complete the "Statement of Intent" section on page two of the application form). Class size is limited based on seating capacity.

Applications must be received **no later than July 6, 2012**. Notification of acceptance into the Fire Inspector Module or the Fire Investigator Module will be sent no later than August 1, 2012.
