DAS Celebrates with CCSU in New Residence Hall Ground Breaking Ceremony

A ground breaking ceremony for a new residence hall was hosted by Central Connecticut State University on Wednesday February 26, 2014.

The new 220,000 square foot residence hall will offer suite style rooms with a living room and bathroom shared by four students. Each floor will offer group study rooms and alcoves for one-on-one studying and socializing. A compute laboratory, game room, and large living rooms will be located on the first floor to create a community center for residents. The state-of-the-art building will also include the University's Residence Life administrative offices and campus-wide meeting space on the first floor.

CCSU President Jack Miller said, "This is a perfect example of the connectivity between the campus and its students. This allows us to increase our ability to recruit new students while at the same time, freeing up space to move students out of older residence halls so that we may renovate them in the future.

DAS Commissioner Donald DeFronzo said, "This is third project we've launched here at CCSU since 2011, and we're not done yet," he said, noting the school will soon begin working on a new dining hall.
