

The following clarifications are applicable to ADDENDUM NUMBER ONE for the project referenced above.

Item 1

The bid opening will be changed from May 13, 2009 at 1:00 p.m. to May 20, 2009 at 1:00 p.m.

Item 2

Refer to Addendum No. 1, Clarification for Item 7: One cell phone will be permitted within the Facility for use by the construction forces. The use of a low powered walkie-talkie will be permitted within the Facility if no radio interference results. Facility Maintenance personnel utilize 154Mz. Custody personnel utilize 800 Mz.

The following clarifications are applicable to specifications and drawings for the project referenced above.

Item 3

Refer to Division 1, Section 01010, "Summary of Work", Item F, The sequence of Work Items 1 through 5 was established in conjunction with the CTDPW and DOC. The renovation of the shower rooms is necessary prior to work on the exterior of the "Q" Building due to the leaking of water from some of the shower rooms to the exterior of the building. There may be some flexibility in sequencing, however, changes in sequencing shall first be proposed by the Contractor and approved by CTDPW and DOC.

Item 4

Refer to Division 1, Section 01010, "Summary of Work", Item F.1, Work Item #1, lines b. through l. Work related to the replacement of the Kitchen windows shall be removed from Work Item #1 and shall become part of Work Item #3. The number of Calendar Days for Work Item #1 shall be revised to 7.

Item 5

Refer to Division 1, Section 01010, "Summary of Work", Item F.2, Work Item #2. Shower room windows shall remain in place during the course of the shower room renovations. The locked temporary construction barrier is not considered adequate security to allow the removal of the window without its immediate replacement.

Item 6

Refer to Division 1, Section 01010, "Summary of Work", Item F.3, Work Item #3.

Revise as follows:

3. Work Item #3 (112 Calendar Days).

Clarification as follows:

- b. Power wash and clean all four sides of Building Q North and Building Q South including existing concrete projected slabs.

Add as follows:

- g. Kitchen shall remain operational during window replacement work.
- h. Relocate existing kitchen equipment as required to perform the work. Coordinate with D.O.C. and Facility Administration.
- i. Erect temporary barrier to separate window replacement work from kitchen operation.
- j. Remove existing Kitchen windows. The removal and replacement of the Kitchen window was planned as a one day effort. Should the effort require more than one day, the Contractor shall be responsible to include the cost of a Correctional Officer guard at all times during non-working hours. The temporary construction barrier is not considered adequate security to allow for overnight absence of a window.
- k. Clean, prepare, and repair existing window openings for replacement windows.
- l. Install replacement windows and glazing.
- m. Install caulking around windows.
- n. Remove temporary barrier. Return equipment to original location.

Item 7

Refer to Division 1, Section 01540, "Barriers and Enclosures", Clarification: The intent of the fenced enclosure is for the storage and protection of materials and building components. All trailers and sheds shall be lockable. They are not required to be within a fenced enclosure.

Item 8

Refer to Division 1, Section 01580, "Field Offices and Sheds", Clarification for Item A.1, The requirements for this item are considered minimum requirements. The Contractor may provide additional equipment as desired.

Item 9

Refer to Division 1, Section 01580, "Field Offices and Sheds", Items A.2 and A.3, Delete these two Items in their entirety.

Item 10

Refer to Division 1, Section 01585, "Identification Badges", Clarification: The Facility will provide construction personnel with clip-on visitor passes at no cost to the Contractor.

Item 11

Refer to Division 7, Section 07900, "Sealants", Item 1.2, "Related Sections", Paragraph A. Revise to read: "Section 03900 – Concrete and Concrete Panel Restoration".

Item 12

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581 "Detention Windows", Item 1.1, Paragraph A.1. Add the following to the Paragraph: "Kitchen windows (Type W-2) shall be steel maximum detention guard-type windows having a horizontal and vertical grid system of steel bulb tee muntins with project-in ventilators superimposed on the inside of the grid."

Item 13

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581 "Detention Windows", Item 1.1, Paragraph A.2. Add the following to the Paragraph: "Detention windows (Type W-1) shall be steel maximum detention guard-type windows having a horizontal and vertical grid system of steel bulb tee muntins with project-out ventilators superimposed on the outside of the grid."

Item 14

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581 "Detention Windows", Item 1.1.A.3, Delete this Paragraph in its entirety.

Item 15

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581 "Detention Windows", Item 1.1A.4, Revise this item to read: "All windows, closure channels, mullions, muntins, sills, covers, glazing beads, and trim"

Item 16

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581, "Detention Windows", Item 1.4.A.3, Add the following to the Paragraph, "Color samples shall be provided for the Pre-Construction meeting or the Window Pre-Installation meeting for selection of window color."

Item 17

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581, "Detention Windows", Item 2.2.B, Revise this item to read: "Windows shall be arranged for aluminum glazing beads attached with tamper resistant screws."

Item 18

Refer to Division 8, Section 08581, "Detention Windows", Item 2.2.G.1, Revise this item to read: "All lites shall be designed for aluminum, screw attached glazing beads."

Item 19

Refer to Division 9, Section 09630, "Cementitious Flooring and Waterproofing", Item 1.1.D. Eliminate this item and all references and requirements for non-slip additives in this Section.

Item 20

Refer to Division 9, Section 09900, "Painting", Item 3.6, under "Product Recommendations", eliminate the requirement for "Interior Showers" to receive "Speedhide 6-7 Interior/Exterior Masonry Latex Block Filler".

Item 21

Refer to Division 15, Section 15413, "Security Plumbing Fixtures". Item 1.2.D references "Sole Source" Memorandum dated August 13, 2008. Memorandum is attached herewith.

Item 22

Refer to Drawing A.1. The descriptions of Work Item #1 and Work Item #3 shall be revised to reflect revisions described in Item 3 and Item 5 of this Addendum.

Item 23

Refer to Drawing A.2, Detail 6 and Drawing A.3, Detail 6. Clarification: These details indicate location and quantity of excavation related to the repairs of the foundation and concrete panels adjacent to grade line.

Item 24

Refer to Drawing A.2 and Drawing A.3, list of "Proposed Repairs". Clarification for Repair No. 9: Weatherproofing of building exterior relates to the cleaning of exterior building surfaces and the application of lime wash coatings specified in Specification Section 03900.

Item 25

Refer to Drawing A.7, Door Schedule. Eliminate requirement for Automatic Door Closer for all doors scheduled.

Item 26

Refer to Drawing A.7. Details 7 and 8 are typical details for window type W1. The referenced details shall be replaced by the details 1 and 2 on Sketch SK.3, "W-1 Detention Window Details", dated 5/04/09 attached herewith.

Item 27

Refer to Drawing A.7. Details 9 and 10 are typical details for window type W2. The referenced details shall be replaced by the details 1 and 2 on Sketch SK.4, "W-2 Kitchen Window Details", dated 5/04/09 attached herewith.




