

Clarification of Razor Ribbon per each detail included on SK 1 is as follows:

Detail 2/SK-1: Two (2) Rows of 30' Razor Ribbon at top of new fence, and three (3) Rows of 30" Razor Ribbon at base of existing fence.

Detail 3/SK-1: Three (3) Rows of 30" Razor Ribbon at base of existing fence.

Detail 4/SK-1: Two (2) Rows of 30" Razor Ribbon at top of new fence.

Item 3

New Gates are to be new.

Item 4

Fence material, mini mesh, razor ribbon, vehicular gate will be provided by the Owner. Persons gate 3'-0" x 7'-0", concrete, bituminous concrete pavement, and vision barrier will be part of Contractor's work to provide.




Division 1, Section 01000, B. 1. is replaced in its entirety with:

Prepare subgrade for and place bituminous concrete paving in accordance to Conn DOT form 813 from west sally port location south to SW corner then east along south perimeter road stopping approximately 20 feet from operational Gate One. Camera junction box across from loading dock will receive a new 6" thick concrete slab 5' x 16". Two (2) 4" diameter concrete filled galvanized steel bollards will be installed adjacent to ground level box. *Three (3) rows of razor ribbon will be installed on new bituminous concrete pavement.*

Prevailing Wage Rates: Prevailing wages are required on this project, in accordance with the schedule provided in the bid documents, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 31-53, as may be amended.

Each contractor who is awarded a contract on or after October 1, 2002 shall be subject to provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Section 31-53 and Section 31-55a.

Wage Rates will be posted each **July 1st** on the **Department of Labor website: www.ctdol.state.ct.us** . Such **prevailing wage adjustment** shall not be considered a matter for any contract amendment.

The wages paid on an hourly basis to any mechanic, laborer or workman employed upon the work herein contracted to be done and the amount of payment or contribution paid or payable on behalf of each such employee to any employee welfare fund, as defined in subsection (h) of section 31-53 of the Connecticut General Statutes, shall be at a rate equal to the rate customary or prevailing for the same work in the same trade or occupation in the town in which such public works project is being constructed. Any contractor who is not obligated by agreement to make payment or contribution on behalf of such employees to any such employee welfare fund shall pay to each employee as part of his wages the amount of payment or contribution for his classification on each pay day.
