

STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. I-6-99

February 1, 1999

This communication is offered in response to your letter to me dated in which you request official interpretations of the 1994 State Building Code (hereinafter referred to by me as the code) in response to the questions which follow:

Question 1: "Does your office license or certify building officials?"

Question 2: "Please identify all classes or grades of building official licensure or certification that your office grants."

Question 3: "Does your office license or certify assistant building officials?"

Question 4: "Please identify all classes or grades of assistant building official licensure or certification that your office grants."

Question 5: "Please identify all other positions that your office licenses or certifies and the classes or grades applicable to each position."

Answers 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5: The licensure of building officials, assistant building officials, and other related building department personnel is not provided for in the code, but rather in statute and regulations adopted pursuant to statute, which as you know, I am not authorized to interpret. I have, in the spirit of cooperation, included a copy of the building official license application, which contains said statutory and regulatory language.
