The Department of Developmental Services Region is recruiting for the position of Regional Director for our South Region, which provides residential and day supports, individual and family support, respite services, and self directed supports, including related case management, clinical services, and facilities management, for more than 4,800 individuals. Regional budget responsibility is approximately \$67 million.

The position is responsible for approximately forty five campus, community living arrangement (CLA), and individual support residential programs in locations throughout the region as well as residential and day services provided through approximately one hundred ten private provider agencies. Management / supervisory responsibility includes more than 950 full and part time staff, including direct care, case management, day services, nursing, occupational and physical therapy, psychology, facilities management, administrative/clerical, and managerial/supervisory staff. The position holds budgetary responsibility for payroll and overtime management, as well as for all other operating expenses including capital improvements, facilities management, transportation and energy, and food.

Qualifications: Applicants must have experience in managing supports and services for persons with mental retardation; knowledge of the principles and practices of self-determination; knowledge of CMS / Medicaid waiver policies, and strong management / supervisory experience in unionized environments, and strong budget / cost control experience.
