The Arc of Meriden-Wallingford, Inc. provides services to adults and children with developmental disabilities and autism throughout central Connecticut. The agency's philosophy is based on the individuals served and our commitment to assure they receive the supports needed to live the lives they choose. Being a highly flexible organization, the Arc is able to offer a wide variety of options as we partner with individuals and families to tailor services to the needs and choices.

Our motto: Your Dream...Our Mission is a reality for our highly trained staff. Along with our mission, this motto guides our focus to self-directed services. The Arc of Meriden-Wallingford listens to families and in fact, family members and individuals served sit on the Board of Directors and steer the future course of the agency. Leading the way into new endeavors and options, the Agency was the first to open a technology house for someone with complex needs affording them the opportunity to live independently in the community. We currently serve over 100 people in individualized services.

Through our business enterprises, we provide job training to assure successful placement in community jobs through our Arc Eatery, Bill's Arc-quaponics and Dot's Thrift store. Once job ready, our Center for Community Employment helps individuals find the job in the community that is right for them. The Agency supports a variety of residential options including apartment living along or with a few roommates and group home settings. The Agency offers free playgroups for children with developmental disabilities and their non-disabled peers, monthly dances for adults of all ages, job club so those employed in the community can get together to socialize and talk about their experiences and challenges. And not to forget those who have retired, the Agency runs a retirement program with lots of socialization and volunteer opportunities.
