Our flagship day program is at our horse farm in Bethlehem. Vocational and recreational programming is on 22 beautiful acres which includes 39 horse stalls, miniature horses, a greenhouse, pottery studio, chickens, guinea pigs, ducks, rabbits, peacocks and much more. We also offer an extensive array of other community experience programming.

Our residential services range from partial day to 24 hour staffed living arrangements. The agency prides itself on obtaining high quality housing that is very affordable. Our philosophy in providing residential services centers around relationships... deep, meaningful relationships is emphasized and is an expected and identifiable component of our residential services.

Other services include a very strong behavioral supports team along with expertise in other clinical services including acquired brain injury, autism spectrum disorders, mental health disorders and school to community transition services.
