The Disability Resource Network Inc. is a consumer-driven, community-based resource organization providing an array of services to young adults and students with disabilities. Our primary mission is to develop and enhance the skills needed to promote an independent style of living, toward the end of becoming positive and productive community members. We primarily are a transition center teaching adults with disabilities independent living skills, vocational skills, self-advocacy, and community access. We offer information and referral services. We are very active in our communities with vocational sites at companies such as Marshall's and Archie Moore's.

The Disability Resource Network Inc. also works with high school students with disabilities. We offer transition programming such as attending PPT meetings and offer an alternative education program. These students are taught pre-vocational skills, independent living skills, and work on academics. We also run a recreation program for high school students that includes visits to the movie theater, mall and events at the Harbor Yard Arena in Bridgeport. We also help families with referrals and applications for the programs that will aid the students when they graduate high school.
