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Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Carmela Smith is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in CT. She also holds a CT school social worker certification (071). She has over twelve years of experience to offer providing supports to individuals with developmental disabilities. She began working as a direct care staff for a private non-profit agency before being promoted to various supervisory and managerial positions. Ms. Smith has also worked for the Department of Developmental Services for over eight years beginning as a case manager then being promoted to a supervisor of case management.

After working for the Department of Developmental Services, Ms. Smith worked for the University of Connecticut as a Clinical Social Worker within York Correctional Institution (Women's Prison). As a Clinical Social Worker at UCONN, Ms. Smith assisted in the development of many behavioral support plans for individuals with various levels of developmental and maladaptive behavioral issues. She also provided individual and family counseling as well as group work and crisis intervention.

Presently, Ms. Smith is an adjunct professor at Southern Connecticut State University.

As part of the behavioral support services, Ms. Smith will provide the following:

- Assessment and evaluation of the person's behavioral need(s);
- Development of a behavioral support plan that includes intervention techniques for increasing adaptive positive behaviors, and decreasing maladaptive behaviors;
- Provision of training for the individual's family and other support providers to appropriately implement the behavioral support plan;
- Evaluation of the effectiveness of the behavioral support plan by monitoring the plan as determined by the team. The service will also include needed modifications to the plan; and
- Be available and responsive to the team for questions and consultation.
