She established the Simsbury Public School's Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) program to meet the educational needs of preschool and elementary students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). She is currently the District-wide Autism Consulting Teacher/Behavior Analyst for this system and works with students from preschool through high school.

Ms. Haley has designed, implemented and supervised home programs for preschool and elementary aged children. She has consulted to school districts though out the state of Connecticut. She has received U.S. Congressional recognition for her work with children with autism.

Ms. Haley has presented her research on autism interventions at The Council for Exceptional Children's national convention and at the Berkshire Association for Behavior Analysis and Therapy annual conference.
