Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Sunrise Northeast is a private not-for-profit corporation whose mission is to provide people with disabilities the assistance and support necessary to enable them to live valued lives in the community. Sunrise Northeast is committed to ensuring that individualized supports and services are designed and provided to build on people's strengths, interests and needs.

Sunrise Northeast has been providing residential supports to individuals with disabilities in Connecticut since 1988 and day supports since 1990. The agency currently supports ninety people in Community Living Arrangements in Eastern Connecticut and two individuals in a supported living arrangement. The agency operates four day programs which provide programs and community experiences to fifty-eight people. Individuals that are supported by the agency range in age from twenty-two to eighty-five. Most of them have physical disabilities and significant medical needs which are monitored by twelve nurses. People supported have diagnoses of eating disorders necessitating gastrostomy tube feedings, seizure disorders, cerebral palsy and many other disorders requiring careful monitoring.

Our philosophy is placing people above all others considerations. Sunrise Northeast continually improves the quality of the programs and services it provides through updating of service philosophy and procedures. Sunrise Northeast provides a broad array of support services for people with disabilities which reduces their dependence on others and increases their social interactions, sense of autonomy and well-being. Our policies and procedures are based upon the ideal that the rights of individuals are a top priority for all aspects of agency planning.

The agency's goals are:



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- *The individual will participate in choices that affect all aspects of his/her life.
- *The individual will live in a home that is focused on his/her growth as a developing person.
- *The individual will learn about and participate in his/her community extensively.
- *The rights of the individual will be paramount in all decisions made by the agency and its representatives.

The organizations ultimate goal is to integrate the people that it serves into the community through advocacy efforts, community education, programs and service.

All of the agency's homes are licensed by the Department of Developmental Services. Since the year 2000 the agency has earned twenty-nine citation free surveys from our licensing inspections. All of our homes have earned two year licenses once the home is opened and on the regular licensing schedule.
