HARC, Inc. was founded by parents of children with intellectual disabilities, long before services were available in the community. Our mission is to assist persons with intellectual disability and their family to enjoy lives of quality, inclusion and dignity by providing support, education and advocacy including: early intervention through the Connecticut Birth-to-System, family support, respite, residential supports, supported employment, adult day programs, recreational and summer camping, behavioral health, elderly enrichment and individual and system-wide advocacy.

HARC's day program has national accreditation through CARF, Inc. Residential programs have licensure by Department of Developmental Services; HARC's Behavioral Health Clinic is licensed by the Department of Public Health. Though HARC has become a large multi-service organization, we have maintained our strong family reflecting our grassroots. The board of directors and committees consist of self advocates, parents, siblings and community leaders.

HARC's informational materials are published in English and Spanish.
