The Center of Hope Foundation provides people with disabilities and their families the resources, services, and opportunities to be contributing members of their communities and to achieve the most fulfilling and meaningful lives possible.

The agency is located in Southbridge, MA on the Woodstock, CT border. Transportation to and from North East CT towns is provided by the Center of Hope.

The Agency has four day habilitation programs that follow a skills training model with medical supports that is individualized for each person.

The Agency also has an Employment Services program that provides vocational and employment skills training, direct job placement, on the job support services, and work evaluations.

The Agency has created many small businesses to provide training and employment to the individuals we serve. Some of these small businesses are Books & Beans (a coffee & used book store), Honest Town Postal (a packaging & shipping business), Hope's Treasures (consignment shop), Yards of Hope (yard work) to name a few.

The Agency also has many sites that individuals volunteer for. Some of the volunteer sites are at local elementary schools, local food shares, Harrington Hospital, Capen Hill Nature Sanctuary, and the Brimfield Public Library
