Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Welcome to the Easter Seals Goodwill Industries Provider profile. For your information, we have provided a brief overview of the services provided by Easter Seals Goodwill Industries (ESGI).

The services provided by ESGI include:

Individual Supported Employment: Assists individuals to seek and secure their own job in the community with ongoing support from ESGI staff. Employment Specialists assist individuals in preparing for the job search, scheduling interviews and securing and maintaining employment. On-the-job training and ongoing support are also provided to assist individuals and employers. Training on how to use public transportation to get to work independently is also available. Transportation is not offered as part of Individual Supported Employment services.

Group Supported Employment: Provides individuals with the opportunity for paid work as part of a small crew in local businesses throughout the New Haven area. Together with a Job Coach, ESGI work crews provide valuable services in retail, light industrial, warehouse, horticultural and manufacturing business settings.

Group Day Supports-Senior People Involved in Community Enrichment (SPICE): Provides an active and creative set of services for individuals who are at least fifty-five years old. Individuals aged fifty to fifty-five will be considered on a case by case basis. Activities include a variety of in-house and community activities that are selected by participants with the assistance of Community Activity Specialists and coordinated with families and residential providers through monthly schedules. Activities include senior centers, bowling,



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volunteering and special monthly outings.

Group Day Supports-Blended Services: For individuals who prefer to split their week between participating in a work crew and community/in-house activities.

Group Respite: An evening and weekend recreation program is available for individuals living with family members or in a Community Training Home and are currently enrolled in an ESGI day program.

Transportation Services: Transportation is provided to and from job sites and community locations for group services. For group supported individuals unable to utilize public transportation, transportation is provided to and from residences but is limited to residents of New Haven and its bordering towns.
