SARAH, Inc. is a private not-for-profit agency qualified by DDS to provide individual supported employment, group supported employment, facility-based day services, transportation, group and individual respite, and interpreter services. We serve over 250 adults in communities throughout the greater Connecticut shoreline. While our participants live and work in many different towns throughout the region, SARAH, Inc. transportation services are generally available from New Haven to Old Saybrook.

Our vision and direction for SARAH, Inc. is to be person-centered and outcome driven. That means we develop and direct our services based on the wants and needs of the people we serve. SARAH, Inc. supported workers are employed in a variety of retail and manufacturing jobs. We offer on-the-job training and support, work site assessments, job development, school to work transitions and case coordination.

SARAH in Action describes all our facility based programs. Located in clean, modern, state of the art buildings, SARAH in Action programs are blended to offer a menu of choices including: paid employment; work and life skills training; social skills development; and volunteer and other community experiences. SARAH in Action enrichment centers are located in Branford, North Haven, Madison and Westbrook.

The SARAH, Inc. extended day respite program currently operates from the SARAH Enrichment Center in Branford. The extended day respite program offers safe, supervised activities beyond the regular work or school day.

SARAH, Inc.'s KIDSTEPS is a state approved, early intervention program of services for infants and children that addresses any identified development delays and disabilities. SARAH Inc.'s KIDSTEPS is also



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approved for services to children on the autism spectrum. KIDSTEPS provides services throughout southern and eastern Connecticut.
