Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

When Social Worker Pauline Lang conceived of the idea that grew into the West Haven Community House in 1941, she envisioned a place that would respond to the varied needs of the people of West Haven. In those days Pauline focused primarily on youth, believing strong support of and advocacy for young people would ensure an equally strong future for West Haven. Seventy years later, serving the community's youngest citizens remains a strong part of the Community House with 163 Head Start families; before and after-school child care for over 300 children and youth enrichment programs for over 250 children.

For 30 years, we have advocated for and worked with the developmentally disabled to meet the special challenges they face in employment, housing and in the community. Our residential program serves 18 adults with developmental disabilities and other mental health issues. Our Community Connections program provides day services for 80+ adults with disabilities. Our program offers activities designed to incorporate skill development, local community integration, therapeutic benefits and health activities.

As the largest private not for profit agency in the City of West Haven, we pride ourselves on taking a leadership role in developing partnerships with other groups in the community to provide a readily available network of services to our citizens. Some of the groups that we collaborate with are West Haven's Adult Education program, West Haven's Interagency Network for Children, West Haven Discovery partnership, West Haven Hispanic Society, and many other smaller groups. We receive support from many sources: fees, memberships, The United Way, a variety of nonprofit, individual, community and corporate gifts and local, state and federal grants. Currently not accepting new ISE clients.
