Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Easter Seals Connecticut has a 46+ year tradition of service excellence with the Department of Developmental Services which enables us to design and implement innovative services for individuals with developmental disabilities. We offer adult day programming, transition from school to work, individualized supported employment, group supported employment, day support options, adult companionship, respite, personal support and transportation. We are a sub-grantee to our National Easter Seals for the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) which is a training program that serves adults 55 years of age and older with low income and poor employment prospects through a grant with the Department of Labor.

The Easter Seals Mobility Center in Meriden provides driving assessments to individuals over 16 years of age who have an injury or impairment that may impact their ability to safely operate a motor vehicle. A clinical assessment is provided, as well as an on the road assessment.

Easter Seals Connecticut provides medical and rehabilitation services that are CARF accredited (Commission on the Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) to children and adults. We operate Camp Hemlocks, the only state licensed overnight Easter Seals camp in CT that provides services to children and adults with multiple disabilities and that has also received accreditation from the American Camping Association (ACA).

Easter Seals Connecticut's Child Development Center is licensed and National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) accredited, full-day, inclusive, school readiness program. We operate a licensed Head Start and State Head Start program which also is NAEYC accredited. In addition, Birth to Three is federally funded by Part C of IDEA under the leadership of the Department of Developmental Services. Easter Seals CT contracts with Local Education Agencies to provide related service personnel i.e. physical, occupational, and speech therapy services that are federally funded by IDEA Part B and local school district budgets.
