**Questions / Answers**

1. Proposal outline indicates C. Declaration of Confidential information. If there is no declaration should the page be numbered #3 and have N/A written on it? **Yes, if there is no declaration, the page will be numbered #3 and have N/A written on it.**
2. Page 9 of the RFP indicates 1 original and six copies should be submitted. Page 45 indicates original and 4 copies. How many copies are required? **Six copies are required.**
3. At Attachment N-no form is provided. Can this be an agency form showing cost savings for multiple awards? **Removed from RFP, form not applicable.**
4. In looking over the outline for the RFP 2011-10310 (see page 26 or see snapshot provided below), two subsections have the same titles but refer to very different things. (Section G-3 relates to “personal preferences...” as stated, but H-1 relates to “personnel” and HR practices. **“Recruitment and Retention” should have been the title not “Personal Preferences and Relationships.”**
5. Due to the extensive fire codes, do you think it necessary to build from the ground up? **Yes, it is probably more practical and cost effective.**
6. Can we do both proposals for cost savings purposes? **Each proposal will be reviewed separately.**
