Dear Family member,

In response to the anticipated retirement of several agency case managers, effective July 1, 2009, the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) will no longer be assigning case managers to individuals who are living in ICF/MR settings operated by private providers.

We will **no longer be able to assign a DDS case manager** as of July 1, 2009.

Your family member will continue to receive the supports and services at their ICF/MR residence and/or day program. The ICF/MR program requires the community living arrangement (CLA) provider to offer service coordination and this will continue through your family member's residence. During the transition period between now and July 1st, you may contact your case manager with any questions. After July 1st, questions about DDS services may be directed to the DDS Private Division in your region.

This is a final administrative decision. I regret any inconvenience this decision may have on you or your family member.
