I am deeply disturbed by the proposed plan, inasmuch as it would most certainly cause irreversible damage on many levels. It would not only negatively affect my quality of life, but the value of my property. Therefore, I respectfully request that this project be halted.

Without getting into the details of why and how this plan would be damaging to our lives, I'd like to point to just a few -- conservation, the environment, wetlands, fish and wildlife, our view, area traffic, pollution due to transportation of the dredging materials, and of course the buffering of noise from trains and I-95. Furthermore, our channel is already being used for industrial barge traffic, which has created an accident not too long ago. It is impossible to add further boat traffic without increasing this hazardous situation.

I think I'm speaking on behalf of all residents of Harbor House (and the entire Harbor Drive neighborhood), when I request that the permitting for the Waterfront Magee LLC be DENIED.
