

Subject: Reporting Reminder

Dear Sir or Madam,

Our records indicate that your facility was registered under the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) General Permit to Limit Potential to Emit (GPLPE) in calendar year 2015. The purpose of this letter is to remind you of your obligation, with a source which was registered under the GPLPE, to submit the required compliance report(s) to DEEP by March 1st.

Due to the transition between the GPLPE issued on November 19, 2010 and a new GPLPE issued on November 9, 2015, the following guidance is being provided regarding compliance reporting for calendar year 2015. All owners/operators of sources which were registered under the GPLPE issued November 19, 2010 shall report according to the instructions in the paragraph below for calendar year 2015, regardless of operating status with respect to the GPLPE issued on November 9, 2015.

All owner/operators of sources shall submit a GPLPE Annual Compliance Certification form (DEP-AIR-CC-003, revision date 10/22/10). The form has not been modified from last year. The Annual Compliance Certification shall cover the period between January 1, 2015 and the permit expiration date of November 19, 2015. If required under the conditions of the GPLPE signed November 19, 2010, any owner/operator of facility with actual emissions greater than 80% and subject to requirement 5(d)(2) of the GPLPE shall also submit an Annual Emission Summary form (DEP-AIR-SUM-003, revision date 10/22/10). The emissions reported on these forms should reflect calculations based upon the period being certified and not the entire 2015 calendar year.

If your facility has reregistered under the GPLPE signed November 9, 2015 a separate report will not be required for calendar year 2015. Submittal of the compliance certification as instructed above will fulfill your reporting obligations with respect to calendar year 2015.

The compliance reports are available for completion and submittal electronically using EMIT online (<https://depapps.ct.gov/>). If you choose not to utilize the electronic reporting option, copies of the forms and instructions are available on the DEEP web site (<http://www.ct.gov/deep>).
