

**Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority (CRRRA):
Hartford Landfill and City of Hartford Refuse Collection Retrofit**

As part of Connecticut's efforts to reduce diesel engine emissions and in concert with Connecticut's Clean Diesel Plan, Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority (CRRRA) has completed its retrofit of Hartford Landfill diesel- powered equipment and will be retrofitting city of Hartford refuse collection vehicles in the immediate future. According to CRRRA's permit and the Host Community Agreement \$150,000.00 was to be used for the reduction of diesel emissions at the Hartford Landfill and \$200,000.00 for the reduction of diesel emissions from the city of Hartford refuse collection operations. As a result of concerted efforts by CRRRA, the city of Hartford, the Connecticut Coalition of Environmental Justice and DEP, sixteen Hartford Landfill vehicles and ten city of Hartford refuse collection vehicles have been retrofitted with diesel emission reductions devices which will result in substantial diesel emission reductions. Estimated reductions of twelve tons carbon monoxide, ten tons nitrogen oxides, twelve tons volatile organic compounds and two tons of particulate matter per year have been indicated.
