We are usually providing one sign per school.

However, in certain situations (such as duplicate bus-loading locations, or multi-building schools) additional signs are needed. Please feel free to adjust the number of signs requested accordingly.

Delivery. Signs are currently being printed, and will be provided according to a prioritized list based on air quality data by county and population. We are trying to collect this information from the schools so that we can deliver the signs to you as soon as they become available for your school system. We will call your designated contact to set up a convenient delivery time.



Posting Signs.

Signs should be posted in a location that can easily be seen from the school bus loading area. We encourage your school system to obtain posts, which your local public works or municipal transportation department may be able to provide, or your local PTA may be able to help purchase. We believe this provides the most visible impact for the no-idling message. Another option is to add the signs to a pre-existing post already in an appropriate location.
