Additional Funding Available
Incentive Program: Public Fleet Electric Vehicles & Public Workplace Charging Stations

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) is pleased to announce an additional funding opportunity under the Public Fleet Electric Vehicles & Public Workplace Charging Stations Incentive Program. Funding is available for municipalities and state agencies to demonstrate their leadership and commitment to market development of zero emission vehicle (ZEV) use through the purchase of electric vehicles (EVs) for their fleets and the installation of EV charging stations for their workplaces. The goal of this program is to support ongoing efforts towards putting 3.3 million EVs on the road by 2025.

Connecticut's cheaper, cleaner and more reliable energy future depends on EVs, which will put us on a path toward greater energy independence. Utilizing funds made available through the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative, DEEP will provide reimbursement of up to \$15,000 per EV and up to \$10,000 per EV charging station meeting the program guidance specifications, to a maximum of six EVs and EV charging stations per grant recipient. The widespread introduction of EVs and additional EV charging infrastructure into Connecticut will also create economic development opportunities while reducing air pollution and moving us closer towards meeting our long term climate change targets.

If your town or agency is interested in supporting Connecticut's clean energy future by adding EVs to your fleet and expanding EV charging infrastructure, I strongly encourage you to review the attached pages containing important information about this program. Your participation will help further our efforts to create economic development opportunities by placing more ZEVs in the state.
