

**THIRD NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF REVISIONS TO AIR QUALITY
REGULATIONS TO
REDUCE OZONE PRECURSORS**

**Amendment of Section 22a-174-20(l) and Adoption of Sections 22a-174-40 and 22a-174-41
of the
Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies**

On September 29, 2006 and February 26, 2007, the Department of Environmental Protection sent to you a copy of a Notice of Availability for the proposed amendment to section 22a-174-20(l) and adoption of sections 22a-174-40 and 22a-174-41 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (R.C.S.A.), primarily to reduce emissions of volatile organic compounds and assist the state in planning for attainment of the federal 8-hour ozone national ambient air quality standard.

On December 20, 2006 and again on March 7, 2007, the Legislative Regulations Review Committee rejected the proposal without prejudice. The Department has again revised the proposal to make technical corrections and intends to submit the revised proposal for action by the Legislative Regulations Review Committee at its meeting on July 24, 2007.
