

To Obtain a Hull Identification Number (HIN) Application:

Request an application from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) Boating Division by telephone at (860) 434-8638, in person at: 333 Ferry Road in Old Lyme, CT, or [online](#).

When completing the Application for a Hull Identification Number:

1. Type or print the information requested;
2. Press hard and print legibly when handwritten;
3. Remember to sign and date the application; and
4. A 60-day Temporary Registration is available at any [DMV](#) office.

Once completed, either mail or deliver in person all copies of the completed application for a Hull Identification Number to:

The DEEP Boating Division may assign a DEEP Inspector, who will contact you to schedule a HIN inspection. After inspecting the vessel, a HIN number will be affixed to it. You will be given a signed copy of your application to present to the DMV for your permanent registration.

If you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment, please notify the DEEP Inspector at least 24 hours in advance.
