The GC3'S **Exploring Climate Solutions** webinar series explores innovative and successful climate change solutions across Connecticut and the nation. The series provides you with first-hand accounts of high-profile municipal climate programs, climate initiatives in the corporate world, greenhouse gas reporting frameworks, statewide sustainability programs, and low-carbon fuel initiatives.

In our upcoming **November 20th lunchtime webinar**, participants will learn about the California PATHWAYS project, a comprehensive analysis conducted by Energy + Environmental Economics (E3) to evaluate the feasibility and cost of a range of potential 2030 targets along the way to the state's goal of reducing GHG emissions to 80% below 1990 levels by 2050. With input from the California Air Resources Board, California Energy Commission, California Public Utilities Commission, and the California Independent System Operator, E3 developed scenarios that explore the potential pace at which emission reductions can be achieved as well as the mix of technologies and practices deployed. An overview of their key findings will be presented.
