Additionally, the initiative will support the building of regional energy assurance capability to allow the State to better coordinate and communicate state-wide, and with other states, on energy security, reliability and emergency response issues. Significant deliverables for this initiative include: Project Management Plan (PMP); Workforce Development Plan (WDP); Energy Supply Disruption Tracking Process (ESDTP); Energy Assurance Plan, both Initial and Final (EAP); Energy Assurance Exercises, both Intra- and Inter- State (EAE); and, Energy Assurance Exercises after Action Reports, both Intra- and Inter- State (EAE AAR). Results for this initiative will be assessed by: number of energy assurance plans created or substantially revised; number of jobs created within State government agencies for energy assurance planning and response capabilities; number of energy assurance training sessions, workshops and/or exercises conducted; and, number of people trained.
