## Seasonal Job Opportunity

**Description:** The Marine Fisheries Statistics Program has a Seasonal Resource Assistant (SRA) position available. The job duties will require in state travel but the duty station will be the DEEP Marine Headquarters located at 333 Ferry Road, Old Lyme, CT.

**Duties:** The candidate in this position will be responsible for performing duties associated with improving the data elements captured during sales of Connecticut's recreational saltwater license. This position will focus on public outreach, in which the candidate will visit remote licensing sites within the state to educate licensing agents as to the importance of the data collection standards necessary for Connecticut's saltwater anglers to remain exempt from Federal Registry requirements. This person will also perform extensive computer-based QA/QC analysis on license data that is provided to the National Marine Fisheries Service. This position includes the development of outreach materials for licensing agents and the general public.

**Qualification:** Must have a valid driver's license, exceptional interpersonal skills and be proficient in MS Windows applications.

**Anticipated Length of Position:** July 30 – January 30. Position is 6 months in duration.
