

<p><u>From points North (Winsted):</u> Take Route 8 south to Exit 44; turn right onto Route 4 and proceed 2.75 miles; turn right onto University Drive and proceed 1 mile to the campus.</p>	<p><u>From points South (Waterbury):</u> Take Route 8 north to Exit 44; go straight at first traffic light; go left at second traffic light onto Route 4 and proceed 2.75 miles; turn right onto University Drive and proceed 1 mile to the campus</p>
<p><u>From points West (Litchfield, New Milford):</u> Take Route 202 to Route 63 north and proceed for 6 miles; turn right onto Route 4 and proceed 4.75 miles; turn left onto University Drive and proceed 1 mile to the campus</p>	<p><u>From points East (Hartford, Storrs):</u> Take Interstate 84 west to Exit 39; proceed approximately 20 miles on Route 4 to Torrington and turn right onto University Drive; proceed 1 mile to the campus.</p>
