

PUBLIC ACCESS HUNTING AT STONES RANCH MILITARY RESERVATION (SRMR)


- Obtain State Land No-lottery Permit and Daily Access Permit from DEEP (<http://www.ct.gov/deep/sportsmenlicensing>). Only properly permitted hunters will be authorized access to SRMR.
- Park in designated parking at SRMR Access Control Point. CTMD is not responsible for security of vehicles parked at SRMR. (See POV parking areas on the map.)
- To gain access to SRMR, check in at Access Control Point – Range Control Building. Check in starts one hour before sunrise.
- When checking in with SRMR Range Control, hunters must present valid identification and the Daily DEEP Hunting Permit for SRMR.
- Hunters who desire to use their vehicle to retrieve a tagged deer must obtain approval from Range Control to gain access.
- Hunters may utilize one (1) tree stand for the hunting season. Tree stands need to be marked with the owner's name and conservation identification number.
- Range Control will authorize vehicle access to allow hunters to transport tree stands to and from the site.
- When authorized vehicular access to SRMR, vehicle must remain on established roads at all time. Hunters' vehicles must be removed from SRMR immediately upon hunter completing task for vehicle access (retrieve deer or delivery/removal of tree stand).
- Hunters must check out with Range Control no later than one hour after sunset.
- Range Control may be contacted at 860-691-4305.
- Hunting at SRMR must be conducted in accordance with all State of Connecticut hunting rules, regulations, and laws.

Instructions for Obtaining Stone's Ranch Daily Permits

1. You must have the appropriate valid state land firearms, archery deer, and/or archery turkey permit (or Resident Game Bird Conservation Stamp) valid for the current season or select one to purchase at the time you apply. All permits will be issued on an individual basis only. Group permits are not available. You may obtain only one permit per day from the list of available areas. Permits can be obtained up to 3 days in advance.
2. Go to the Connecticut Sportsmen Licensing site at <http://www.ct.gov/deep/SportsmenLicensing>
3. Select **START** at the bottom of the page.
4. Enter your Date of Birth and Conservation ID#. Select **NEXT** to log in. If you cannot log in, follow the instructions on the page for new or previous customers.
5. After logging in, check your profile information. If your profile information is not correct or is incomplete, select **Edit Profile** to update your information.
6. Select **NEXT** to continue.
7. If you have not yet obtained your 2016 licenses, permits, or stamps, add the type of license, permits, and stamps you want to your shopping cart.
8. Select the **Other** link at the top of the page.
9. Find **Daily Permit** on the list of items and select the **ADD** button.
10. You may then select Stone's Ranch and a day to hunt. The menu will only display areas and dates for which daily permits are still available. Select the **ADD** button to make your choice and then select **OK**. The daily permit for the day you selected will be placed in your shopping cart. There is no charge for these permits.
11. You may add additional daily permits for different days or shop for other permits.
12. When finished, select **NEXT** to proceed to **CHECK OUT**. Complete any required items at **CHECK OUT** and then select **SUBMIT**.
13. Select **PRINT LICENSES/PERMIT and RECEIPT**. The hunting area and date that the daily permit is valid for will be printed on your Conservation License. You will need to reprint your license every time you obtain additional daily permits.


