



**Notice of Reissuance of the General Permit for the Discharge
of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities
(with modifications)**

The Department of Energy & Environmental Protection (DEEP) hereby gives notice it has reissued (**with modifications**) the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities (construction general permit).

The current construction general permit expires on September 30, 2013. The new construction general permit will become effective on **October 1, 2013**. New registrations for construction projects under the new general permit may be submitted any time after the date of this notice. In addition, under this new construction general permit, permittees already authorized under the current construction general permit will be required to re-register under the new general permit by February 1, 2014.

The permit and record of the Commissioner's final decision are available on the DEEP website at www.ct.gov/deep/permits&licenses. The permit, forms, instructions, tools and guidance materials may be found on the DEEP stormwater webpage at www.ct.gov/deep/stormwater. DEEP will send correspondence to existing permittees regarding the re-registration requirements on or before October 1, 2013.
