

SUMMER 2008 CT DEP MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FULL COST ACCOUNTING SURVEY
REPORT 3 – Municipal Recycling Programs

To search responses by individual towns/cities, type the town/city's name into the search box at the top of the PDF.

Report 3 provides 2008 survey information related to the types of recyclables collected curbside in individual Connecticut municipalities, whether they were collected single stream or dual stream in 2008, and the amount individual municipalities spent on recycling outreach in 2008.
