- b) did not establish or create a facility or condition at or on such brownfield that can reasonably be expected to create a source of pollution, as defined in section 22a-423 of the general statutes, to the waters of the state;
- c) is not affiliated with any person responsible for such pollution or source of pollution through any contractual, corporate or financial relationship other than a municipality's exercise of such municipality's police, regulatory or tax powers or a contractual relationship in which such person's interest in such brownfield will be conveyed or financed; and
- d) is not otherwise required by law, an order or consent order issued by DEEP or a stipulated judgment to remediate pollution on or emanating from such brownfield.
