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## HAZARDOUS AND CONNECTICUT-REGULATED WASTE COMPENDIUM

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### What is the Compendium?

This compendium provides a list of documents from DEEP, EPA, and other relevant agencies concerning the management of [hazardous waste](#) and [Connecticut Regulated Waste](#) in Connecticut. These documents are typically letters or memos written in response to a particular question about the requirements for hazardous waste and Connecticut-Regulated Waste. Although provided as useful guidance, these documents are specific to the particular fact pattern on which they are based. Any interpretations provided may not apply in all cases.

The documents are presented in a table that begins on the next page. The documents are arranged first in order of subject matter, and then by date. Each row in the table includes the following information for each document:

Subject/Topic: A brief description of what the document is about.

Date: The date of the document in year/month/date format, where the first four numbers represent the year, the next two numbers the month, and the final two numbers the day (i.e., YYYYMMDD).

DEEP Reference Number: The internal DEEP reference number assigned to each document. This reference number also includes a hyperlink that allows you to access to the document from the DEEP website.

Key Words: Words that identify key issues or topics discussed in the document.

### How Can I Use the Compendium?

You can use the document on-line, or download it onto your own device. Either way, the hyperlinks to the documents are live and allow you to directly access the documents. You can look through the list for documents that you are interested in, or perform a search by typing "CTRL F" and entering a search term that you think best addresses your area of interest. To access a particular document in the list, just click on the reference number and it will pop up. Note: all the documents are in PDF format, so you need to have Adobe Acrobat in order to access them.

Once opened, the text of each document is searchable. To find a particular word or words in a document, type "CTRL F" and enter the words.
