I am writing with regards to the Sediment Remedial Action Plan for the Mill River in Fairfield, CT.

As a Fairfield resident, I would like to see those involved move beyond remedial investigations and reports. I am in full support of the clean-up of the Mill River in as expeditious a manner as is possible. I do not feel the Department should consider delaying remediation of the Mill River until such time as Superior Plating is prepared to address chromium contamination emanating from its manufacturing facility. I do not believe that such delay is warranted.

Understanding that few things ever go according to plan, I believe the Department's expeditious review and approval of a Remedial Action Plan for the Mill River is imperative so that clean up can proceed forthwith. It is my understanding that this is an outcome based plan, and that it is incumbent upon the applicant to demonstrate compliance and to ensure that all clean-up objectives have been satisfied. I would specifically like to request placement and enforcement of appropriate noise and odor controls during work to minimize impacts to adjoining property owners.

I look forward to returning this strategic site to productive use in the very near future and thank you for this opportunity to comment.
