DISCUSSION AND 48-HOUR OUTLOOK

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AT 900 AM EDT...1300 UTC...THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION ONE  
WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 14.6 NORTH...LONGITUDE 64.3 WEST. THE  
DEPRESSION IS MOVING TOWARD THE WEST NEAR 9 MPH...14 KM/H...AND  
THIS GENERAL MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH THE NEXT 48 HOURS.  
ON THE FORECAST TRACK...THE CENTER OF THE DEPRESSION SHOULD REMAIN  
OVER OPEN WATERS IN THE SOUTHERN CARIBBEAN.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 30 MPH...45 KM/H...WITH HIGHER  
GUSTS. SLOW STRENGTHENING IS FORECAST...AND THE DEPRESSION COULD BECOME  
A TROPICAL STORM ON FRIDAY.

THE ESTIMATED MINIMUM CENTRAL PRESSURE IS 1007 MB...29.74 INCHES.
