

# WHERE'S YOUR KI?

If you WORK in or are a **NEW** or **SEASONAL RESIDENT** of East Lyme, Groton City, Groton Town, New London, Old Lyme, Waterford, and portions of Ledyard, Lyme, and Montville, the State's nuclear preparedness program and your community have arranged for you to obtain your you can obtain **Potassium Iodide (KI)** tablets at the following locations in the town you reside or work. The planning standard is one (1) KI tablet per person.

**Potassium Iodide (KI)** is an over-the-counter drug that can help protect your thyroid gland from radioactive iodine, one of the potentially harmful emissions that may be released in a nuclear power plant accident. **KI** is a *supplement* to the primary protective actions of evacuation and or sheltering and should only be taken upon direction of State officials.
