



BANDS OF HEAVY RAIN MOVING INTO WESTERN CONNECTICUT...
WINDS INCREASING ALONG SOUTHWEST COAST...
HIGH WIND WARNINGS REPLACED BY WIND ADVISORIES...

At 5:15 AM radar showed a solid line of showers and thunderstorms in Eastern NY stretching down the East Coast to the Del-Mar-Va peninsula and off shore of Cape Hatteras. This band of moderate to heavy rain is slowly sliding to the east and is entering Western CT at this time. South winds are currently gusting to 40 MPH along the CT coast and are also gusting to near 35 MPH inland across higher elevations.

The area of heavy rain along the East Coast is forecast to move across Connecticut during the next 6 – 8 hours bringing torrential downpours and winds gusting to 40 – 50 MPH at times. The heavy rain may cause urban flooding and the strong winds will cause some additional tree and powerline damage. The morning rush hour will be difficult in Western CT with strong winds and heavy rain west of I-91 causing delays and some accidents especially for high profile vehicles in exposed areas.

Towns are advised to continue to closely monitor this storm as it moves through the state. Conditions are expected to improve from West to East starting at 10:00 AM in Western CT, Noontime in the Hartford area and by 2:00 PM in Eastern CT.

The Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security will continue to monitor this storm and will issue the next weather conditions update at 7:15 AM.
