a SEARCH WARRANT SERVED RESULTING IN AN ARREST***

March 11th, 2014 at approximately 0800 hours

In East Hampton

Case # CFS14-00127813

After several months of a collaborative investigation by the East Hampton Police Department and the Statewide Narcotics Task Force – North Central Field Office a search and seizure warrant relating to a firearms and illegal drug sales investigation was executed for the 93 Main Street, 2nd floor apartment in East Hampton.

Detectives from the Statewide Narcotics Task Force, Investigators from the East Hampton Police Department and Special Agents from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security executed the Search and Seizure Warrant. A Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Referral was also made to the Department of Children and Families (DCF), who responded, and is conducting their own independent investigation.

ARRESTED:

Hansen, Erich (DOB: 07-28-1981) of 93 Main Street, 2nd floor, East Hampton, CT 06424

CHARGES:

Possession of over a ½ ounce of Marijuana; c.g.s. 21a-279(c)

Possession of a Controlled Substance; c.g.s. 21a-279(c)

Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell; c.g.s. 21a-277(b)

Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell within 1500 Feet of a School; c.g.s. 21a-279(d)

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia; c.g.s. 21a-267 (a)

Criminal Possession of a Firearm; c.g.s. 53a-217c

Illegal/Unsafe Storage of a Firearm; c.g.s. 53a-217(a)

(2 COUNTS) of Risk of Injury to a Minor; c.g.s. 53-21

Erich Hansen was held on a \$150,000.00 BOND with a court date of March 12th, 2014 at Middletown Superior court/G.A. #9.

SEIZED as a result of the investigation:

A loaded 38 caliber revolver, One hundred and five (105) 38 caliber rounds, a digital scanner locked into the East Hampton PD radio frequency, forty-one 'Adderall' pills, approximately eight (8) ounces of marijuana, a digital scale and \$1,078.00 in U.S. Currency.
