Duties may include but not limited to: The principal psychiatrist will cover a 22 bed coed unit treating a severe mentally ill (SMI) population and also serve as the clinical team leader for the unit's multidisciplinary treatment team. The principal psychiatrist will provide direct psychiatric care to patient's ages 18 to 60+ with longstanding SMI, including admission, diagnosis, treatment, psychopharmacology, biologic treatments, group, family, psychosocial therapies and discharge. The principal psychiatrist will oversee and participate in development of integrated treatment plans and monitor their effectiveness. As a team leader, the principal psychiatrist will help define the mission of the unit and the services needed to be provided, in order to insure individualized treatment for the clients on the unit. The principal psychiatrist will provide clinical oversight of the multidisciplinary treatment team; and will be involved in P/I initiatives, UM/UR functions. The incumbent will conduct or participate in treatment team meetings, staff meetings and program development meetings. Incumbent serves as a member of the CVH Total Medical Staff.

General Experience - Incumbents in this class must possess and retain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or board certification in Adult or Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

Special Requirements - Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f).

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable. **To be considered for this position:**
